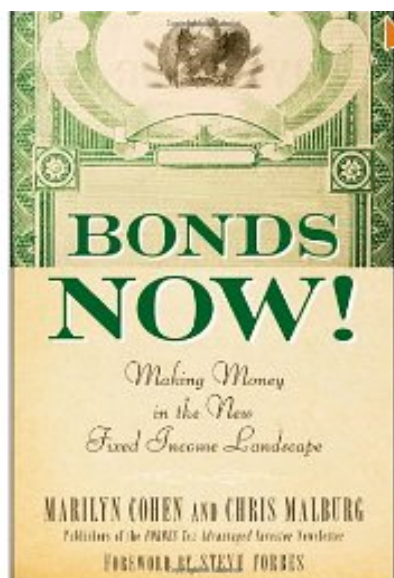


## Bonds now!
